Weather-stripping:

Weather-stripping is designed to reduce air leakage around parts of your home that must move relative to one another, such as doors and windows. It is easy to install and one the most cost effective home improvements. Make sure the area where you plan to install weather-stripping is free and clear of all debris and moisture.

Step 1: Cut weather-stripping into desired lengths, measuring tape may be required.

Step 2: Remove roughly 1" of adhesive backing from the strip and apply the exposed foam onto the desired location.

Step 3: Continue removing small sections of the adhesive backing to apply foam, while working your way down the entire length.

Step 4: Allow the foam weather-stripping time to properly adhere to the surface before creating any friction.
